

# LATEST UPDATE ON YOUR COMMUNITY

We have a number of exciting construction updates to share with our community.

Stages 41 and 42 have now titled, with titles expected for Stage 43 in the coming weeks. Water main installation is also underway in Stage 45.

In Meridian Green, earthworks in Stage 46 are now complete, with sewer works still in progress. In Stage 47, earthworks have commenced and are set to be complete shortly thereafter.

The majority of services along Hardys Road between Zagros Street and Burlina Boulevard are now complete, with road pavement works now taking place. Kerbs have been installed, with asphalt set to be laid in the months ahead and finished before the end of the year.

Significant progress has been made at the intersection of Hardys Road and Berwick-Cranbourne Road, with works anticipated to be completed by the end of 2023. For further updates, please visit the City of Casey's website: casey.vic.gov.au/road-projects-hardys-road.

Intersection works at Thompsons Road and Bells Road are ongoing. The intersection is open under the supervision of traffic management, with Thompsons Road and Hardys Road providing access to Meridian Green. Please note, these works are being delivered by an external organisation, and we will provide further updates when we know more.



# SPRING GARDENING TIPS

Now that spring has officially sprung, it's time to prepare your garden for the warmer months ahead.

**Get planting:** If you've been dreaming of a veggie patch or just want to refresh your garden beds, the spring weather provides optimal growing conditions for new plants. Be sure to research what plants are best suited to the climate and conditions of your backyard.

### RESIDENT INFORMATION

#### Landscaping incentive

In order to be eligible for the landscaping incentive, you must have your front garden, including the driveway, nature strip and side fences completed within 90 days from the date of your Occupancy Permit. Please refer to your Contract of Sale and your Developer Approval drawings for the specific requirements for your lot.

#### **Perimeter fencing**

If you aren't planning on building straight away, it is still important to secure your property. Please organise temporary fencing for your property to prevent the dumping of rubbish. It is a costly exercise for you as the home owner if clearing is needed prior to construction.

#### Shared fencing

All shared fencing should be arranged in collaboration with your neighbour.
